



## NOMINATION FORM FOR ELECTION AS OWNER MEMBER

Persons nominated for the position of owner member of the Managed Forest Council must be nominated by owners in good standing, which is defined as owners who:

- (a) hold a current management commitment for Managed Forest land,
- (b) have been Managed Forest landowners for a minimum of 3 years, and
- (c) do not have any outstanding fees or penalties under the *Private Managed Forest Land Act* or Regulation.

Under the *Private Managed Forest Land Act*, council members 'must be knowledgeable in matters relating to forest management practices or local government.' Refer to the Member Profile Guidelines and the Council Governance Policy – Section D Terms of Reference for additional criteria for the election of owner members.
